The General Education GPA must be at least 2.5. The General Education GPA will be calculated using one course from each of these 6 areas AND Psychology 9.

Math 35 (or higher) is suggested since it counts for both the Math graduation competency (starting in catalog year 2009-2010) and Analytical/Critical Thinking. Applicants who have had continuous enrollment from before the 09-10 academic year though will not need to complete Math 35 (or higher) for graduation. Students that need to test out of Math 35, call Counseling at 222-8440.

Applicants who have completed ALL pre-requisites AND general education courses BEFORE applying have a much greater chance of being admitted. Getting into the RN program is competitive. Applicants who meet all deadlines, have complete files and who have the highest point have the best chance of being invited into the RN program. Applicants who are invited to the RN program must have a valid U.S. Social Security number, pass the background check, drug screening and health clearances before enrolling. The application periods are January 2—February 2 and September 1—October 1.

Pre-requisite GPA

The combined GPA for Anatomy & Physiology 2A/2B and Microbiology must be at least 2.5 for 1st semester RN applicants. It must be at least 2.3 for LVN to RN applicants

The above GPA values may only apply if the 3 courses are all the same unit value. If the A&P courses and Microbiology have differing unit values, the GPA must be calculated accordingly.
