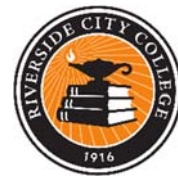

CGACC-RCC International Student Scholarship Application

Instructions

The Application deadline for the CGACC-RCC International Student Scholarship is July 25.

Results of students selected are announced by August 6.

To be eligible for consideration for the scholarship, you must be:

- An international student who will study full-time at an RCCD college on an F-1 Student Visa in the fall semester.
- New international students who apply for the scholarship must have completed RCCD international student application on file, submitted all required application documents, and received an RCCD I-20.

To apply, submit the following documents via email to internationalcenter@rcc.edu:

- This application form including a 300 to 400-word short essay and
- If you are a continuing student, submit unofficial transcript; if you are a new student, submit TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, ITEP, or LanguageCert (IESOL) test score.

The scholarship committee will select the most qualified applicants based on merit (The total score of points will be based on the applicant's overall GPA/the TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, ITEP, or LanguageCert (IESOL) score and the essay).
