

2020-2021 RCC Student Employment Dates to Remember

***Please note that students should not be working the holidays unless there is a special event.**

Summer Session (June 22 – July 30)

June 30th – Last day students can work for the 19-20 academic year based on spring enrollment.

July 1st – First day of employment for the 2020-2021 academic year. Students may work if hire paperwork has been processed and the supervisor has been notified in writing of the approval. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units for summer and have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA to be eligible to work.

July 3rd – Holiday

August 23rd – Last day students can work for the summer session if they do not plan to return for the fall semester. Students may work July 31st – August 23rd while classes are not in session based on summer enrollment.

Fall Semester (August 24 – December 16)

August 10th – The first day students may work for the fall semester if they were not enrolled in summer, but are enrolled as of this date for fall in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

September 7th – Holiday

November 11th – Holiday

November 26th – Holiday

November 27th – College Closed

December 25th – Holiday

December 26th – January 1st – College closure for winter holiday. Students may work under staff supervision during this time except for the December 26th and January 1st holidays.

Winter Session (January 4 – February 11)

January 1st – Holiday

January 4th – First day students can work for the winter session. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

January 18th – Holiday

Spring Semester (February 16 – June 11)

February 1st – First day students can start working for the spring semester if they were not enrolled in winter session, but are enrolled as of this date for spring in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

February 12th, 15th – Holidays

March 31st – Holiday

April 12th – April 16th – Spring Break – students may work during spring break if their funding or budget allows it.

May 31st – Holiday

June 11th – Commencement – students may work from June 12th through June 30th based on spring semester enrollment if they have funding or budget remaining.
