

2010-2011 RCCD Scholarships

Scholarship Listings

For your convenience, the scholarship listings are separated into categories by major, club activity, and other criteria. The scholarships are listed in the following categories:

- **Athletic Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must be a member of an RCCD athletic team and meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Business, Computer Information Systems, Law Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Education Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Engineering Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Fine Arts Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Miscellaneous Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **No Major Required Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Nursing Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must *currently* be accepted in the nursing program, enrolled in nursing classes at RCCD and meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Re-entry Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must be 25 years old at the time of application and meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Science Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must meet the criteria listed in the brochure.
- **Student Activities, Club Involvement, or Community Service Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must have completed the number of ASRCC service hours listed and submit your ASRCC Service Hours Log and/or verification of community service hours to the Riverside City Campus Student Activities Department by Friday, November 14, 2008.
- **Vocational Scholarships** – to apply for these scholarships you must *currently* be enrolled in a vocational program at RCCD and meet the criteria listed in the brochure. Vocational scholarships are awarded to students whose education will end at RCCD with either a Certificate or an Associates Degree and who will *not* be transferring to a four-year school.

Some scholarships in this brochure have multiple criteria, so they will be listed in each section to which they apply. You will only require *one* application for those specific scholarships even though they are listed several times.

Other Criteria Listed in the Scholarship Description

Continuing or Transfer – This refers to your student status for the *2010-2011 academic year*.

- If you will be remaining at and attending Riverside Community College District during the fall 2010 and spring 2011 semesters, you are classified as a *continuing* student and you may apply for scholarships listed as "Continuing" or "Continuing or Transfer."
- If you will be leaving RCCD by transferring to and attending a four-year school during the 2010-2011 academic year, you are classified as a *transferring* student and you may apply for scholarships listed as "Transfer" or "Continuing or Transfer."
- If you will be attending Riverside Community College District for the fall 2010 semester and transferring to a four-year school for the spring 2011 semester, you are classified as a continuing/transferring student and you may apply for scholarships listed as "Continuing," "Transfer" or "Continuing or Transfer."

Please pay close attention to your status as a continuing or transfer student. If you list it incorrectly on your online scholarship application, you may not be considered for some scholarships. If your status as a transferring student changes after you have submitted your application, please contact the scholarship specialist at the Riverside City Campus.

CGPA – This is the minimum cumulative GPA that is required to apply for each scholarship. We will use your cumulative GPA at Riverside Community College District including the fall 2009 semester grades. Your grades and units from other schools will **not** be included in your cumulative GPA for scholarship purposes.

Financial Need? – If there is a "Yes" in this column, the donor requires that applicants for this scholarship have financial need as determined by completion of the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The Title IV Code for RCCD is "001270." Please complete the FAFSA prior to submitting your scholarship application. Students that have not completed the FAFSA will not be considered for any need-based scholarships.

Amount – Some scholarship amounts will be listed as "varies" because the award amount can change from year to year. You will be notified of the exact amount in your congratulation award letter and/or your disbursement information letter.
