Eligibility Requirements

- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible noncitizen
- Be a California resident
- Submit a complete 2009/2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the Federal Central Processing Center. (Students can fill out and submit the 09/10 FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- Meet federal Selective Service filing requirements
- Maintain at least half-time enrollment in approved courses leading to a Permit
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP) as defined by the postsecondary educational institution
- Be nominated by an eligible postsecondary institution or nominated by the employing agency
- Commit to full-time employment in a licensed children's center in California for a period of one year for each year of benefits received
