3. Grading policies (relies primarily)

4. Educational program development (relies primarily)

5. Standards or policies regarding student preparation and success (relies primarily)

6. District and college governance structures, as related to faculty roles (mutually agree)

7. Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including self-study and annual reports (mutually agree)

8. Policies for faculty professional development activities (relies primarily)

9. Processes for program review (mutually agree)

10. Processes for institutional planning and budget development (mutually agree)

11. Other academic and professional matters as mutually agreed upon between the governing board and the Academic Senate. (mutually agree)
