### 4. APlus Attendance

- a. Thea Quigley joined to provide insight on the software and how it has been implemented so far.
  - i. The program has been piloted with non-credit attendance in CTE and in the Nursing program, and will be used by the engagement centers during winter.
- b. APlus Attendance is a web-based program that can be logged onto with a common username and password
- c. Students can sign in by swiping their student ID card or entering their ID number. There are discussions with APlus Attendance if a student email option can be implemented.
- d. The following questions were asked which Thea relayed to the APlus Attendance representative
  - i. Can a student select multiple reasons for their visit to the area?
  - ii. Can the solution be adjusted so that a student can only utilize services once per 24 hours (so ASRCC can use this to monitor who has received food)?
  - iii. Can a student be logged into multiple spaces at the same time?
  - iv. Can there be an option where a student is automatically signed out? This would be useful for spaces where students are picking up resources (food, toiletries, school supplies).
