- Role in accreditation, especially 4?
  - Clarified: Ensure all constituents represented in accreditation; the focus is on Standard IV
  - Suggested charge: Ensure representation of constituent voices in Standard IV
- Function mapping and relation to district strategic planning?
  - Clarified: Collaboration on portions of the function map development and implementation; the primary focus is on Standard IIA, IIIA, IV; representative voice of this group in DSPC
  - Suggested charge: Ensure collaboration in district strategic planning and function map development
- Participatory governance in relation to guided pathways?
  - Confirmed
  - Suggested charge: Ensure participatory governance in fully implementing a guided pathways framework
- Coordination and completion of assessment and improvement of governance and decisionmaking processes?
  - Clarified: Ensure lines of communication among the leadership constituents; forum to clarify governance and decision-making processes; Collaboration on major events; rumor control; in the event there is a recommendation generated from this body then determine process in bringing forward through the planning process
  - Suggested charge: Ensure communication and collaboration in the assessment and improvement of governance and decision-making processes
