- a. Goal: increase transfer by 20%
 - i. The STEM division has been highlighting and connecting students with internships and research opportunities, especially with UCR and CSUSB
 - 1. These encoderation opportunities, especially with OCR and CSUSB
 - 1. These opportunities allow students to become familiar with a potential transfer institution and allows students to make personal connections at the transfer institution

 - v. Formalize a Communication Plan
 - 1. Provide guidelines on how to contact students
 - a. Will allow us to be more efficient with our student communication
 - vi. Include career and transfer information in all courses

 - a. Will provide unavoidable, consistent transfer and career information
