- ➤ Counseling due to Guided Pathways the support team dynamic is introduced and changes the past practices described in the survey
 - Certified trailheads will be sent out in the next month or so
 - Students will have student success teams counselors for specific career pathways, faculty in that path, counselors in that path, etc.

- > Standard IIBC Iceberg
 - Above the surface visible accomplishments and results with the standards
 - First responders to crisis management moving to caseload management with general counselors and engagement centers full, wrap-around support
 - Integrated support in categorical programs and other grant funded related support
 - Underneath the surface identify areas of improvement
 - Standard IIC better management of communications at all levels
 - How messages are communicated, not just to students, but across the board faculty, staff, departments and district
 - o Extended hours for evening and weekend services
 - o Up-to-date and active directory on the website
 - Dr. West and his department is taking lead
 - Clear access to student technology Webadvisor, MyPortal, Open Campus, and Outlook 365
 - District is preparing to revamp technology platforms overload is an issue
 - Dr. Carter can bring list of vendors and names to the next meeting

- MyPortal and Webadvisor students do not have interchangeable access, however WebAdvisor is the default program for if MyPortal goes down
- o Campus-wide student services
 - Everyone is support for a student Department leads and Deans are charged with getting their departments' first five questions a student asks when coming into their area
 - Dr. Carter has also challenged the other vice presidents to do the same in their areas
 - Desk reference is being compiled for each area so no matter where the student is asking their question, they do not have to leave the area to get the answers
 - A summer 2019 project with a fulfillment date of first day of the fall 2019 semester
 - How do faculty approach students or answer questions for students, specifically health services?
 - Dr. Carter explains the liability with assessing students in classroom for mental health issues
 - Students responsible to give the faculty their accommodations, but cannot be initiated by faculty
 - Dr. Perez- suggests faculty training for assisting students and understanding the right steps to take
 - o Invite Dr. Smith into departmental meetings, Flex day sessions
- o Early Alert Emails/Letters
 - Letters have been modified and revised to make it more inviting
 - Geby Rawung positive experience with this letter to assist with her successful academic accomplish
 - Are the Health Services included in the letter for students?
 - There is a statement letting students know there is assistance in this area if they are interested
 - Mixed reviews on Early Alert for the faculty
