



## ADDENDUM - FEBRUARY 2024

The language in bold below has been updated to conform to Title IV guidelines.

### WHO MAY ATTEND

Individuals who meet any one of the following criteria are eligible to attend the three colleges of Riverside Community College District:

- Have graduated from high school
- or
- Have passed the CA High School Proficiency Exam or
- Have passed the GED examination
- or
- Did not graduate from high school but are 18 years of age or older
- or
- Are eligible high school students in grades 11 and 12, who have been approved for concurrent enrollment in both high school and college
- or
- Are eligible high school students in grades 9-12 who have been identified and approved by their high school as a dual enrollment student
- or
- Are international students who have satisfied specific international student admissions requirements by a specified deadline. Admission to Riverside Community College District-Riverside City College is regulated by state law as prescribed in the California Education Code.

***If the School has reason to question the validity of a student's high school diploma, the student will be notified they can continue enrollment but will not qualify for financial aid/Title IV funds.***
